MOVING FORWARD FROM COVID-19

The Division continues to work as effectively and efficiently as possible while adhering to state and national health standards. Despite enhanced safety measures, the typical initial processing time for most paper-based applications continues to be well within our 2-4 week time period; however, we appreciate your continued patience and understanding during this time if your application takes longer to process than usual.

- Most design profession applications continue to be reviewed electronically by staff or the Board as mandated by the respective statute.
- Scheduled Board meetings continue to be held via a web-based platform or cancelled if unavoidable.
- PearsonVue and Prometric test centers are open and exams are being administered for all NCEES and NCARB exams. Each site may have additional restrictions in place so please consult the respective entity.
- At this time, no CE/PDH changes have been implemented for the Architect, Land Surveyor or Structural Engineer professions that are scheduled to renew this year on November 30, 2020.

RENEWAL REMINDER

The Architect, Land Surveyor and Structural Engineer licenses are set to renew this year and will expire on November 30, 2020. We recommend that you ensure that your current email address is on file with the Department in order to receive the courtesy renewal reminders. The link to review and update your contact information is below.

In the beginning of September, all active licensees will receive an email from the Department with instructions on how to renew online.

You are required to submit proof of completion of your CE/PDH's **only** if any of the following apply to you: you submit a paper renewal form after the expiration date, you are restoring your license to active status or are requested to do so by the Department as part of a random audit.

Note: As a reminder, part of the CE/PDH requirement must include one hour of sexual harassment prevention training.
