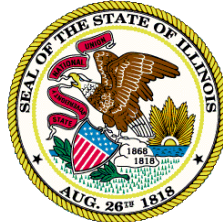

P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, the Division of Banking recognizes that, Hurricane Florence will be negatively affecting the southeastern region of the United States beginning on or about September 11, 2018 which will interfere physically with conduct of normal business operations at state-chartered banking offices, savings banks, and trust companies throughout the that area, and any branches thereof carrying on the business of banking.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 2 of the Banking Emergencies Act [205 ILCS 610/2], the Division of Banking authorizes state-chartered banking offices, savings banks, and trust companies located in Illinois, and any branches thereof carrying on the business of banking, to close for all or part of the normal business beginning on the day of September 11, 2018, and thereafter, until such time as normal business operations are no longer affected by the emergency.
